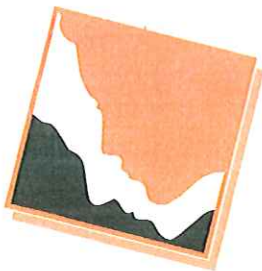

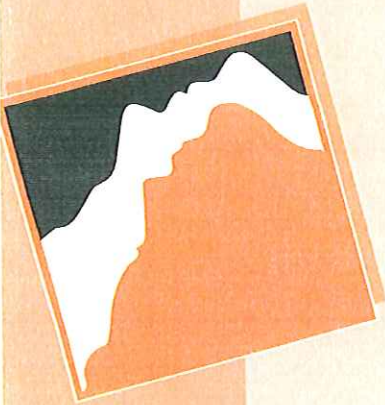

- Titles must be kept as they appear on brochure.
- Entries must also include an electronic copy in Microsoft Word (CD or USB drive) and works cited.
- Application form must be included.
- Entries must be postmarked by January 31, 2017.
